
1) Admission:

In the academic year 2019 - 2020 admission process was started from 1st June 2019. Total 143 prospectuses were sold. 115 students did registration. Common entrance test was held on 20th June. 108 students were present for this exam. On 22th June, the first merit list was displayed. As per merit 44 students were given admission for M.S.W. 1st year, and 38 students were given admission for M.S.W. IInd year.

2) Result of the college:

As per the rules and regulations of Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University Aurangabad the exam was conducted in March/ April 2019. Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwda University Aurangabad held M.S.W exam. In this exam, Ashruba Sanjay Khandare got 76.80% marks and stood



first in the college. Santosh Ramchandra Khamkar with 75.70% stood second. The result of fourth semester is 92.10%. Students who performed well in exam and fieldwork activities were congratulated by staff of college and dignetaries of Manavlok Organization.

3) Student-teacher-parent-management meet:

Student-teacher-parent-management meet is organized every year in the college, after completion of M.S.W admission process. Newly admitted students and parents are given information about the rules of the university, discipline in the college, attendance in field work, report writing, revision etc. As a result, college attendance remains above 90 percent.

On 17.07.2019 Students- Parents- Teacher – Management Meet was organized. Dr. Babasaheb Kokate, Associate Professor, (member of Academic Council of

Dr.BAMU) Balbhim Mahavidyalaya Beed expressed his valuable thoughts on "Indigenous thoughts and Human Life". Parent's representative Shri.Kishanrao Pandhare was president of the program. Shri. Manoharrao Kakade and Dr. Prakash Jadhav gave their guidance. Total 42 Parents were present in this programme.

4) Library:

The book exhibition was organized at Manavlok Social Work College. This book exhibition was inaugurated on 31.07.2019 by Mr. Abhijit Jondhale, a renowned social worker. The puepose of book exhibition was to familiarize the newly admitted students with the rare and new books in the college library. On this occasion, the Mr. Abhijit Jondhale gave guidance on the topic of 'Book reading culture'. He said that a man should read to live like a man. Social worker Baba Amte, Nelson Mandela, Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar, Mahatma Phule, Mahatma Gandhi etc. great person's thoughts and ideals can be understand by reading their biographies. Industrialist, political leader, patriot Bhagat Singh etc. many noblemen maintained reading and writing even while in the jail. Autobiography, autobiography, novels etc. literature increases positive thinking level and vocabulary is also increased. Today's technology should be used with discretion, and the habit of reading literature should be developed. He gave many examples of bibliographies.

Dr. Nazeer Shaikh introduced Abhijit Jondhale and his work. Dr. Prakash Jadhav said that students shall read Rishimuni's, Tukarama's Abhanga, Harry Potter as examples, giving the message that "If you read, you will survive", the importance of reading was convinced. Librarian Mrs Vanita Machwe thanked everyone. At this time the college professor Dr. Arundhati Patil, Dr. Rama Pandey, Prof. Sukeshani Jogdand, Prof. Kisan Shingare, Dr. Hanumant Salunke and non teaching staff Shri. Bibhishan Ghadge, Mr. Ramdas Kale, Smt. Dipali Ghodke, Deepak Kulkarni, Shivaji Pallewad and all the students of the college participated in this book exhibition program.

As many as 5832 curricular and social science related stories, novels, literature, encyclopedias are available in the college. Apart from this, 29 periodicals of various publications and about 10 newspapers at national, state, divisional, district and local levels are available. The library has a separate reading room for students and faculty. Apart from this, an e-library has been arranged in the library. N-List Inflibnet, OPAC facility is available in the library to make e-book resources available to students and faculty. Apart from this, four computer sets are kept in the library for the convenience of the students. Students who have read more extra-curricular books throughout the year were felicitated with excellent reader certificates. Rohini Laxman Raut, M.S.W. First year, Ashish Mohanrao Bhandarkote was congratulated with the certificate as the best reader from the second year. A book review competition was held for the academic year 2019-2020 in which Pratibha Pandurang Maske ranked first and Namdev Ashokrao Shinde ranked second.

5) Fieldwork:

Field work is an integral part of social work. Students studying social work need to be introduced to different social work organizations. The purpose of fieldwork is to inspire the students to do social work, create sensitivity towards the neglected, deprived,

blind, disabled, mentally challenged, elderly, ill and victims in the society. Also Orientatvisitsion visits are organized for the purpose of giving information to the students about the institutions working for the rehabilitation. Fieldwork includes Orientation visits and fieldwork visits.

A) Orientation visits-

The orientation visits are organized to study various organizations working in the field of social work, their functioning, services provided, nature of services and overall administration. The following institutes were visited in the academic year 2019-2020 to familiarize the students with these institutes.

On dated, July 15, the workshop was conducted regarding the orientation visits of the first year students. Manavlok Ambajogai, Manaswini Mahila Project Ambajogai, Jeevan Aadhaar Project Girvali, Bodhvardhini Vidyalaya Ambajogai, ICTC Center Swami Ramanand Tirtha Medical College and Hospital Ambajogai, Rural Police Station Ambajogai were visited in connection with the orientation visit.

B) Fieldwork -

In field work practicum the Knowledge of social work is demonstrated in the community and in various institutions. Agency based (case work, group work) for first year students and placement in different communities for second year students. In the agency-based field work, the students adopted two methods of social work, Case Work and Group Work. Under this method, students deal with individual problems of a person in the institution. Client selection, understanding problem and enabling client to solve hios own problem by using the principles and techniques of casework. In the group work method, formation of group of people with similar problems, problem analysis and group process to find the right kind of solution done with the participation of group members. Group work is done by using the principles, techniques, and skills of group work method. The second year students have gone to different communities and demonstrated the third method of social work in community organization. Under this approach, he worked with the community at the community level to understand the community, identify community issues and solve them. At the same time, the students carried out field work projects, community based research on various issues in the community. In this two year course, students try to study all the six methods of social work. Students also participated in activities like Morcha, statements to various government departments etc.

Fieldwork Workshop: Before starting the fieldwork, the students were informed about the difficulties faced while doing actual fieldwork, problem identification, intervention design, role of social worker, responsibility, routine etc. through the workshop. This workshop was conductes on July 15, 2019. The main theme of this year's field work was "Study of Water Sources and Current Status in Ambajogai City". A fieldwork workshop was conducted in this regard. Dr. Arundhati Patil guided the students.

In Ambajogai city, the drinking water situation has become very bad due to the drought that has been going on for the last three to four years. In the year 2019-2020, Nizamkalin wells, Barav, Aad and other water sources in Ambajogai city and its surroundings were studied under the field work of college students. A total of 3520 houses in 07 wards of Ambajogai city were visited. During this visit, 27 wells, 07 baravs, 103 aads, 13 hand pumps, 2269 borewells were found. Out of these, 57 bore wells, 03 wells, 01 wells, 13 hand pumps were found to be closed. Observations during the visit are as follows -

- 1. There is water up to 20 feet on public and private grounds.
- 2. Accumulation of garbage and filth in the public well has polluted the well water.
- 3. 10 percent bore is recharged in the city.
- 4. Wastage of tap water was observed on a large scale.

6) Rural Camp:

Manavlok's College of Social Work, Ambajogai organized rural camp for the MSW II semester students. It is a compulsory 5 days activity given in the syllabus. This camp provides opportunities to students about experiences of rural life analyze rural dynamics and observe the local self-government and voluntary organizations. It also helps to develop skills, study the government schemes and report their experiences.

Rural camp was organized in eight villages for first year students. Economic and social survey of eight selected villages was conducted for the students under this camp. Apart from this, the rural camp was organized according to various aspects like understanding the rural areas, economy, social system and local administration, identifying the needs of the people, ranking the needs. Rural Participatory Appraisal (PRA) was conducted in a total of eight villages selected under Shibira. In this process, demonstrations were conducted on Village Social Map, Shiwar Pheri, Chapati Diagram, Property Valuation etc. College professors and institute workers participated in this process. A total of 40 students participated in this rural camp.

7) Study Tour:

Manavlok Social Work College organized study tour for M.S.W 4th semester students, there are guidelines given in the syllabus for organizing study tour for 25 marks as a compulsory part of the syllabus. According to the guidelines, the coordinator and the students have to take decisions regarding the planning of the study tour. According to the planning correspondence did for getting the approvals from institutions to be visited from 06th January to 16th January 2020. Total 42 persons participated. One student did not participate in the study tour due to her personal reasons. Extension activities were provided for her as provision in the curriculum.

During this study tour, the students got information about the geographical structure, house structure, cropping system, province wise language style, uniform etc. after observation and also the administrative structure of the NGO working in the social sector, daily working procedures, tribal development projects implemented in the organization, women empowerment, volunteering in the context of environmental protection role of organization etc. Information was taken as well as Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam, former President's memorial was visited, and information about his work was taken. In this study tour, information was gained about the activities of NGOs in Maharashtra and NGOs in other states. During the visit to the Swami Vivekananda Memorial at Kanyakumari, information about Swami Vivekananda's work for the youth was learned. Also gained knowledge about importance of communication, time mananagement etc. During Nimhan's visit, it was learned that Alzheimer's, Dementia, Neurology, Neurosurgery, Depression, addiction and various mental disorders are treated and researched.

8) Department of Life Long Education and Extension Services:

Since 2003, the college has been imparting intellectual knowledge along with vocational knowledge to the college students every year on behalf of Lifelong Learning and Extension Department under the Extension Education Department of the University. 9) Various Committees:

A) Anti-Ragging Committee - The Anti-Ragging Committee has been set up as per the Maharashtra Government Act to ensure that the new entrants do not suffer any mental or physical harm from the above students. Since it is a college that teaches social work, there are no forms of ragging in college. The rites of non-discrimination are practiced in the college on the basis of gender equality, socio-economic inequality. To date, no such complaint has been lodged with the committee. As the chairman of the committee, Dr. Arundhati Patil looks after the work.

- **B)** Internal Complaints Committee As per the bill passed in the Lok Sabha in 2013, a committee has been set up in the college for prevention of sexual harassment against women. Dr. Arundhati Patil works as a coordinator of the committee.
- C) Internal Quality Assurance Cell IQAC has been established in the college for quality enhancement. Efforts are made to enhance the quality of the college by exploring internal and external resources. As the coordinator of this committee, Prof. Dr. Rama Pande look after this work. In the academic year 2014-2015, the college was evaluated under NAAC. In order to enhance the internal quality of the college and the students, the committee held 06 meetings from time to time and carried out the instructions and facilities as demanded. Career Mentoring Camps, Competitive Examination Camps, and Mentoring Camps on Study Related Topics were organized for the students. On behalf of this committee, minorities, backward classes, students who are lagging behind in studies, special needs students (disabled) were assisted.

D) Social Justice and Empowerment Committee –

A Social Justice and Empowerment Committee have been established in the college as per the directives of the University Grants Commission, NAAC and Higher EducationDepartment of the Government of Maharashtra for the benefit of the students belonging to the Scheduled Caste Tribes, Freed Caste Nomadic Tribes and Other Backward Classes. This committee has seven members and four members are student representatives. The Principal is the chairman of the committee and the teacher's representative is Prof. Sukeshini Jogdand was selected.

10) Employment Guidance Cell:

On behalf of this cell, students and alumni are provided guidance, counseling as well as campus interviews on the availability of job opportunities in various places. At the same time, students living in remote areas are given information about job advertisements by giving messages. The purpose of setting up the cell is to provide jobs to more and more college students. On behalf of Employment Guidance Cell, Guidance, Counseling, and Campus Interviews are organized for the passed out students regarding job opportunities available at various places.

The objective of the program was to inculcate the approach of social work for village development, and to reach Gandhi's philosophy. Gandhi Vichar Sanskar Pariksha is being organized in the college on the occasion of Mahatma Gandhi's birth anniversary for the last seven years. 18) Research Centre:

Manavlok Social Work College, Ambajogai has approved a research center by Dr.Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Aurangabad. 13 students are doing Ph.D. under the research center.

19) Other Activities:

- A) Student Insurance: Total 82 students were insured from United India Insurance Company Ltd. A one year policy was issued.
- **B)** Health Checkup: On 05th October 2019, the health checkup camp for students of the college was conducted. This includes CBC, blood sugar etc. Abhijit Kharat and staff from Primary Health Centre, Bhavthana were present for the health examination. Total 35 students and staff were examined.
- C) Flood Relief Work: Manavlok social work college done relief work for flood victims of Sangli and Kolhapur districts. Rivers like Krishna, Yerala, Panchganga, Warna etc. flowing through Sangli and Kolhapur districts were flooded due to heavy rains in June and July 2019. On 08.08.2019, a boat accident took place at Bramhanal village in Sangli district and 17 persons drowned. As the flood situation worsened, many problems had arisen and it became very necessary to supply and support the people there with food grains, clothes and other essentials. Considering all these situations, Manavlok Organiztion took the initiative to help the flood affected people of Sangli and Kolhapur districts. On 10.08.2019, Prof. Kisan Shingare, Shri. Hussain Chaudhari, Manik Kukde, Abhijit Kapse and Laxmikant Dhumal reached Sangli district for relief work. After reviewing the situation, immediate relief work was started. People had a problem of two meals a day. To solve it, Manavlok Organization started public

food facility at Brahmanal, Vasgade, Padmale, Mauje Digrus, Rajapurwadi, Kurundwad etc. places.Manavlok arranged food for the needy people. At the same time, due to the flood, there was a large amount of river silt and garbage in people's houses and on roads. Many animals were also dead. Manavlok has sent three JCB machines to Sangli district for removing mud from roads and disposing of dead animals. A team of workers also entered with them and very necessary work was done like removing garbage, sludge, disposing of dead animals, channeling the accumulated water. 15000 people were provided two meals a day through the Community Kitchen Project.

In the meantime, all the staff and students of Manavlok Social Work College prepared 1000 kits of food grains which are enough for one month to help the families in Flood affected area. Between 30th August and 01st September, students, Principal, teaching and non-teaching staff of the college went to help the flood victims of Sangli.

D) Participation in social movements

- On December 20, 2019, the professors and students of the college participated in a march to protest the rape of a schoolgirl at Kholeshwar School Ambajogai.
- On January 08, 2020, M.S.W First year students participated in a march against the attack at JNU Delhi. Along with Dr. Arundhati Patil, Dr. Rama Pande, Prof. Kisan Shingare was participated in the agitation march.
- Dr. Reddy, veterinary officer rape case was happened. Students and professors of the college participated in the protest against the incident. After the protest rally Dr. Arundhati Patil, Shri. Aniket Lohia, Principal Dr. Prakash Jadhav submitted the statement to Deputy Collector.

E) Participation in National Programmes:

Pulse Polio: Students of the college involves in the national program and participate to make this campaign successful. On January 19, 2020, 38 students of the college were present for pulse polio vaccination at the bus stand, Yashwantrao Chavan Chowk, Shivaji Chowk, Panchayat Samiti, Yogeshwari Mandir, Bhagwan Baba Chowk, and Municipal Auto Rickshaw Point in Ambajogai city. Students were given polio vaccination training on 18 January 2020.

Blood Donation Camp: An annual blood donation camp is organized on the occasion of the foundation day of Marathwada Navnirman Lokayat (Manavlok). A blood donation camp was organized this year too. 18 blood donors donated blood at Swami Ramanand Tirtha Medical College and Hospital Ambajogai.

20) Government of India Scholarship Scheme:

On behalf of the Government of India, the backward class students were given scholarships in which a total number of 49 students were benefited. Students belonging to SC-21, NT-18, SBC-01, SEBC-03, Minorities-01, Tribal Division-05 got the benefit of the Government of India Scholarship Scheme.

21) Publication:

- Manavlok Research Bulletin: Manavlok Research Bulletin is published quarterly by Manavlok Social Work College. It is an independent publishing of the college. This Quarterly with issue number 2349.3984 was sent regularly to 30 members in Maharashtra. Research based articles are published in this quarterly.
- Gajar: The college publishes a special issue of 'Gajar' twice a year with the aim of inculcating the habit of reading and developing interest in writing for the overall development of the students. Various subjects are given to the students for writing articles.

22) Parivartan Prakalp:

From September 7, 2012, the teaching and non-teaching staff of the college has started Parivartan Prakalp from their ownl financial aid. A 'Parivatan Prakalp' has been started to implement social, economic, educational, health related activities in Satephal village of Ambajogai Tahsil. The objective of this project is community development through people's participation. The work like establishing and promoting self-help groups, solving problems of community with the help of people themselves, improving the quality of education, solving health problems, making them literate to get protection from violence against women etc.

23) Block Placement Training:

Block placement training is a mandatory part of the social work program. Second year students are sent for one month to reputed NGOs in Maharashtra. Under B. P. T. Students are assigned task for one month to gain hands-on experience of the activities of NGOs, donors, donor agencies and experience of administrative work. Due to the Corona crisis, the students were not sent for block placement.

24) Department of Student Welfare - Earn and Learn Scheme:

This scheme is run under Dr.Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University Aurangabad Student Welfare Department. Vasantraoji Kale Swabhiman Shikshan Yojana (Kamwa and Shika) is being implemented in the college since December 2014. The scheme is implemented by combining 50 percent share of the university and 50 percent share of the college.

33) Co-curricular Activity

Case Presentation:

Learning supportive activity is a part of syllabus for M.S.W first year students. Under this activity students are given various social problems in the society like education, water management, drought, social justice and equality, various social laws etc. 45 issues were allotted to students for study. After studying the above subject, the students have presented a detailed report in the college.

Seminar:

Orientation visits are important to understand the institution and their social work. First year students are given visits to local government and semi-government institutions. Second year students are given visits to government and semi-government institutions, industries, ideal villages in the state of Maharashtra. At this time, the students study the day-to-day functioning, management, and working methods of the organizations. After the visit, the students are presented group wise seminar on the function of visited institutions.

34) Extra Curricular Activity:

Soft Skills

Soft skill development is necessary for personality development. With this aim of overall development of the students' soft skill development classes is conducted in the college. When students pass out from the college they have to work in various government, semi-government offices. So for that students are required to prepare resumes and also understand administrative records etc. For their preparation of personal interview guidance is given in soft skill development class.

Healthy Practice:

In order to maintain good atmosphere among the teaching and non-teaching staff and management in the college, various exercises are done on 15th August 2019. The flag was hoisted by Shamsunder Sarwade. Class IV employees are promoted to celebrate various anniversaries of great persons. It helps to build their confidence and create sense of equity.

Field Action:

For the last four years, Beed district has been experiencing drought. The effect of this drought is also seen on the water supply and water source in Ambajogai city. Ambajogai town faced drinking water shortage due to low rainfall. In order to study this water problem, Manavlok Social Work College started researching the traditional water sources available in Ambajogai town. When the entire area was studied, it was observed that Ambajogai city has Nizam period lakes and some places have wells and dams. If they are used properly, some amount of water problem can be solved. In the present study, facts were collected through 131 families and this report was prepared by discussing with water supply department related persons, political persons, persons working on the subject of water etc. In this program students and professors of the college were participated. Students submitted a report through direct survey, visit, observation etc. A total number of 19 wells were investigated in Bada Lake area. Out of that 13 wells have water. But the water in this well is not suitable for drinking due to silt and garbage. If these wells are desilted, they can be used. The current status of all these wells and other water sources was informed to Ambajogai Municipality through a report and presentation on the study.. On that, the municipality assured that they will take appropriate measures for reviving the wells.

35) Extra Activity:

INSTALLATION:

This program was conducted on 06.09.2017 with the objective to provide learning opportunity and develop observation skills among students. Five groups were made in this program. Each group was given a separate topic. Topics like cleanliness, superstition, watershed, farmer suicide, education etc. were given in it. The students made an installation on the above topic using the available equipment in the college premises and gave a group presentation.

Bhumika:

Along with the curriculum, various activities and presentations are organized for the students in the college every Thursday. An innovative initiative called 'Bhumika' is published on the first Thursday of every month. In this program, students are expected to write their opinions, thoughts, perspectives on current affairs, social, political, economic, cultural issues/problems/situations. On this occasion, the college has provided a good opportunity to the students to express their thoughts in written form.In the academic year 2019-2020, an innovative activity 'Bhumika' was conducted in which the students chose a topic on the current social problem and presented it in detail.

Skill Development:

A skill development program was conducted for the first year students. Dr. Nazeer Sheikh tried to impart education through entertainment and games. This includes

students' concentration, teamwork, playfulness etc. Subject information was given with demonstration. Skill development is mainly used for community organization.

Awareness Songs:

On the second Thursday of the month, Janajagrutipar Geet is conducted in the college. The students are made aware of the patriotic song. It gives them inspiration, enthusiasm and inculcates social values of life. The songs which express the life of farmers, labourers preferred. On the second Thursday of the month, 05 students from the first and second years sing awareness songs.

Shramdan:

Shramdan is organized in the college every Thursday from 10:30 am to 11:30 am in order to inculcate the culture of hard work among the students and to understand the importance of cleanliness. All the students of the college, all the employees of the college participate in Shramdana. Cleaning of the premises, cleaning of the bathroom is carried out.

Khadi Uniform:

According to Dr.Dwarkadas Lohia, the founder of Manavlok, all social workers of the organization as well as all the employees and students of the college should wear khadi uniform on every Monday and Thursday, in respect of leaborers working in Khadi manufacturing.

Prayer:

College starts at 10:25 am with prayer. At this time, all the student and staff stands in a row and take the prayer written by Saneguruji, 'Khara to Ekchi Dharma, Jagala Prem Arpave'. This activity helps to maintain discipline and values are inculcate among participants.

Parivartan Project:

05 elderly people were distributed kits through Parivartan Prakalp. Bibhishan Ghadge, Ramdas Kale, Ashok Kedart participated in this program.

Accommodation for Non-Teaching Staff:

The institute has provided accommodation for Class IV staff within the college premises. Suhas Mali, Annasaheb Shende, Shivaji Pallewad avail the staff accommodation.

Awards:

On the occasion of Muknayak Day, the Ambajogai Taluka Journalists Association honors the persons working in different fields in the society by giving Muknayak Award. On January 31, 2020, the office superintendent of the college Mr. Ashok Kedar was felicitated with a memento as 'Mooknayak' for his social work.
