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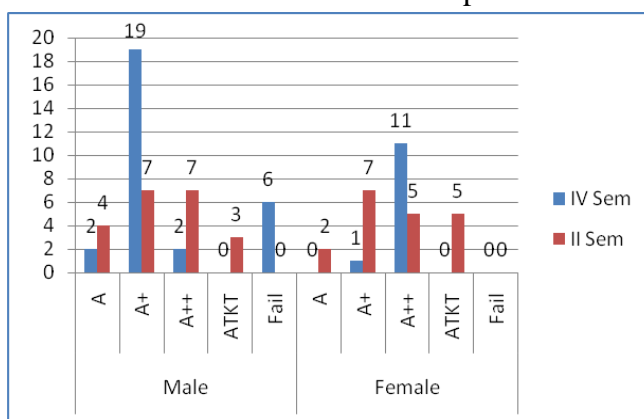
1) Admission:

There was fear of spread of COVID-19 hence admission of MSW first year started from 4th September 2021 to 20th September 2021. Online google form was developed to invite applications for admissions. The first merit list was declared on 23.09.2022 after resolution of all doubts and complaints. According to the merit list, M.S.W. 40 students were admitted for the first year. In the second year, 37 students were given admission.

2) Result of the college:

As per the rules and regulations of Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University Aurangabad the exam was conducted in March 2021. Top five merited students in Social work course are students from, Manavlok's College of Social Work Ambajogai. University First- is Sarswati Manikrao Chate (87.20%), Second- Akshay Ashruba Neharkar(86.40%), Third- Pooja Bhimashankar Kshirsagar(86.30%), Fourth- Pratiksha Sakharam Borde (85.90%) and Fifth- Rohini Laxman Raut (85.40%). The average result of Fourth Semester is 85.36%. and the average result of second semester is 80%. In the academic year there were total 40 students appear for the exam but Shital Dahiphale, Jayashri Ghanwate and Sandhya Kambale these three students didn't took admission for the academic year 2021-2022 due to this reason students drop out rate observed 7.50% in this year.



3) Student-teacher-parent-management meet:

Student-teacher-parent-management meet is organized every year in the college, after completion of M.S.W admission process. Newly admitted students and parents are given information about the rules of the university, discipline in the college, attendance in field work, report writing, revision etc. As a result, college attendance remains above 90 percent, in the academic year 2021-2022.

On 01.12.2021 Students- Parents- Teacher – Management Meet was conducted. S.R. Anitaitai Tarkashe was the President of this program. Dr. Babasaheb Gore, Principal, Janvikas Mahavidhyala, Bansarola, was the chief Guest of the Program. Dr. Prakash Jadhav explained the rules and regulations about attendance, discipline and punctuality. Shri. Aniketji Lohiya told about the vision and mission of the college. In this program 45 parents and 60 students were present. Dr. Rama Pande was the coordinator of this program.

4) Library:

In the college library, there is Cloud Based Libman Software facility provided. For students, N-List is facilitated to use online books and journal resources.

The college has 6046 syllabus-related and reference books, stories books, novels, literature, encyclopedias related to social work subjects. In addition, there are 11 magazines of various publications and national, state, divisional, district and local level newspapers. The library has a separate reading room for students and professors. In addition, an e-library has been set up in the library. The N-List, Inlibnet, OPAC facility is available in the library to make e-book resources available to students and professors. In addition, the library has four computer sets for the convenience of students. The head of the library and his colleagues strive to make the library more useful and important.

B) Fieldwork –

In field work the Knowledge of social work is demonstrated in the community and in various institutions. Agency base (case work, group work) for first year students and placement in different communities for second year students. In the agency-based field work, the students adopted two methods of social work, Case Work and Group Work. Under this method, students deal with individual problems of a person in the institution. Client selected and work was done to solve the problem of the problem person using the principles, techniques and techniques of casework. Under the group work, form groups of people with similar problems and explain their questions through the group. Group work was done using the principles, techniques and skills of group work. The second year students have gone to different communities and demonstrated the third method of social work in community organization. Under this approach, he worked with the community at the community level to understand the community, identify community issues and solve them. At the same time, the students carried out field work projects, community based research on various issues in the community. In

this two year course, students try to study all the six methods of social work. Students also participated in activities like Morcha, statements to various government departments, Baitha Satyagraha.

6) Rural Camp:

Manavlok's College of Social Work, Ambajogai organized rural camp for the MSW II semester students. It is a compulsory 5 days activity given in the syllabus. This camp provides opportunities to students about experiences of rural life analyze rural dynamics and observe the local self-government and voluntary organizations. It also helps to develop skills, study the government schemes and report their experiences. A rural camp was organized at Mauje Dhavandi for the MSW second semester students. It was conducted from 27.05.2022 to 31.05.2022. A total of 06 groups of students were formed in the rural camp. Six groups were given separate subjects. To study the six subjects, the students had a meeting with the villagers, Gram Panchayat members and government employees working in the village and studied the rural life. In this camp, PRA techniques were taught to the students and studied as follows.

Group-1: Initiative taken to create social mapping. This activity included main roads, religious places, government buildings, drinking water facilities, banks etc. in the village.

Group-2: Explored natural resources including information about watercourses, land types, rivers, crops, horticulture etc.

Group-3: was related to seasonal calendar. The group produced seasonal calendars depicting rainfall, water levels, crops, irrigation, water resources; Information about seasonal crops was collected.

Group-4: History of the village, population growth, changing rainfall, water level, changes in cropping etc. were studied.

Group-5: To study the village, a map of the village was prepared by means of 'chapati' diagram, in which the village institutions, village schools, post office, village house structure etc. were studied.

Group-6: The means of livelihood of the villagers were observed. The main occupation, secondary occupation, sources of income of the village was studied.

In the said course, the students visited the village premises to study the village in depth and inspected the natural resources and also visited the sources of the catchment area implemented by the Manavlok NGO. CCT, LBS, Checkdam etc. were studied in it. Also, on the last day of the camp, the students presented their studies and problems in front of the villagers. Dr. Nazir Sheikh and Dr. Rama Pandey acted as the coordinator.

7) Department of Lifetime Education and Extension:

From 27.05.2022 to 31.05.2022 MSW. 35 students of Chaithya session conducted extension work camp at Hatola, Seluamba, Kolkandi, Varapgaon in Ambajogai taluk and Dipevadgaon and Palaskheda in Kage taluk. Meanwhile, Dr. Kisan Shingare accompanied the students to Seluamba, Kolkandi, Varapgaon, Dipevadgaon and Palaskheda. As coordinator Prof. Sukeshini Jogdand observed the work.

Objectives of Extension Work:

- To understand the nature and scope of work of institutions/organizations providing social development services keeping in mind the social reality.

- To understand the role of social work and other sectors of developmental activities and services.
- To develop personal and professional responsibility in community life and interpersonal relationships
- To acquire the skills of planning, organization, evaluation, cooperation, coordination etc.

Implementation:

The planned expansion work actually started on 27th May 2022. According to the planning done by the student group, each group went to their respective villages and got information about the villages, information about village leaders and resources, development plans being implemented in the villages for the last five years, role of gram panchayats and voluntary organizations, changes in the villages, interviews with beneficiaries, filming, village monitoring participation, transparency, information about the plans.

The coordinator and co-coordinator supervised the extension work in the villages carried out by the students. During this supervision, the students were guided about the difficulties they face, how to acquire information, and the role of social work. The villages Seluamba, Kolkandi, Varapagaon and Dipevadgaon were visited.

Each group was sending their location according to which the students were asked to enter the location on the mobile after going to the village and before returning from the village. Location is considered to be the physical presence of the students.

An experience sharing activity was implemented on 31st May 2022 for each group to get the experience of each village. Presentations of student groups were also held on the same day. Principal of the college Dr. Prakash Jadhav, Coordinator of Extension Work Prof. Sukeshini Jogdand, Co-Coordinator Dr. Kishan Shingare was present.

On 02 June 2022, the reports of the students were collected.

A one-day workshop was conducted to inform the students about the work to be done under the extension activities. The coordinator and co-coordinator guided the students in this workshop.

8) Various Committees:

A) Anti-Ragging Committee - The Anti-Ragging Committee has been set up as per the Maharashtra Government Act to ensure that the new entrants do not suffer any mental or physical harm from the above students. Since it is a college that teaches social work, there are no forms of ragging in college. The rites of non-discrimination are practiced in the college on the basis of gender equality, socio-economic inequality. To date, no such complaint has been lodged with the committee. As the chairman of the committee, Dr. Arundhati Patil looks after the work.

B) Internal Complaints Committee - As per the bill passed in the Lok Sabha in 2013, a committee has been set up in the college for prevention of sexual harassment against women. Dr. Arundhati Patil works as a coordinator of the committee.

C) Internal Quality Assurance Cell – IQAC has been established in the college for quality enhancement. Efforts are made to enhance the quality of the college by exploring internal and external resources. As the coordinator of this committee, Prof. Dr. Rama Pandey oversees this work. In the academic year 2014-2015, the college was evaluated under NAAC. In order to enhance the internal quality of the college and the students, the committee held 06 meetings from time to time and carried out the instructions and facilities as demanded. Career Mentoring Camps, Competitive Examination Mentoring Camps and Mentoring Camps on Study Related Topics were organized for the students. On behalf of this committee, minorities, backward classes, students who are lagging behind in studies, special needs students (disabled) were assisted from time to time.

D) Social Justice and Empowerment Committee – On behalf of the Social Justice and Empowerment Committee of the College, Dr. A workshop was held on 22.11.2021 on Constitution of India: Fundamental Rights and Duties. Ravi Gaikwad, scholar of Indian Constitution, guided the students in this workshop. First and second year students participated in this workshop.

Constitution Honors Exam was organized on 26 November 2021 on the occasion of Constitution Day of India. A total of 68 students participated in this examination. Participating students were given participation certificates.

d. On 14 April 2022 On the occasion of Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar's birth anniversary Dr. Bhumika Bhattisheet competition was organized on various aspects of Babasaheb Ambedkar. The first, second and third ranked students in the competition were given books as prizes by the professors of the college. Sukeshini Jogdand was selected.

9) Employment Guidance Cell:

On behalf of this cell, students and alumni are provided guidance, counseling as well as campus interviews on the availability of job opportunities in various places. At the same time, students living in remote areas are given information about job advertisements by giving messages. The purpose of setting up the cell is to provide jobs to more and more college students.
