Minimum intake of each elective course should be ten.



B) Fieldwork -

In field work the Knowledge of social work is demonstrated in the community as well as in various institutions. Agency base placement i.e.case work, group work for first year and different communities for second year students. In the agency-based field work, the students adopted two methods of social work, Case Work and Group Work. Students use these methods to deal with individual problems of a person in the institution. Client selected and social work tools and techniques are applied for helping client to solve their own problem by enabling them. In group work method, persons with similar problem are focused. Group work was done using the principles, techniques, and skills of group work. The second year students have gone to different communities and demonstrated the third method of social work i.e.community organization. Students in their fieldwork visits try to identify needs and issues if the community. They worked with the participation of community dwellers to understand the community, identify community issues and solve them by applying various techniques of community organization. At the same time, the students carried out field work projects, community based research on various issues in the community. In this two year course, students try

6) Rural Camp:

Manavlok's College of Social Work, Ambajogai organized rural camp for the MSW II semester students. It is a compulsory 5 days activity given in the syllabus. This camp provides opportunities to students about experiences of rural life analyze rural

It also helps to develop skills, study the government schemes and report their experiences August rural camp was organized at Mauje Dhavandi for the MSW second semester students. It was conducted from 27.05.2022 to 31.05.2022. A total of 06 groups of students were formed in the rural camp. Six groups were given separate subjects. To study the six subjects, the students had a meeting with the villagers, Gram Panchayat members and government employees working in the village and studied the rural life. In this camp, PRA techniques were taught to the students and studied as follows.

7) Study Tour:

Study tour of MSW II year students was organized from 10.03.2023 to 15.03.2023 at Hyderabad. Youngisthan Foundation, NIRD, TISS, Moulana Azad National Urdu University and L.V.Prasad Eye Hospital were visited to understand social work intervention of above institutions. 15 male amd 16 female students were participated. Prof. Sukeshini Jogdand was the coordinator and Dr. Kisan Shingare worked as co coordinator of study tour program. Along with NGOs and other institutes some turist spots like Birla Mandir, Husen sagar, Nizam Palace, Govalkonda Fort, Botinical Garden, Neckles Garden, Charminar etc places were visited. Study Tour expenditure was rs. 3342/- per student. 5girl students from economic weaker section were assisted by Manavlok with rs.3000/-. This program is a part of syllabus for 25 marks. One girl student could not join study tour, hence she was given an assignment.

8) Various Committees:

- A) Anti-Ragging Committee The Anti-Ragging Committee has been set up as per the Maharashtra Government Act to ensure that the new entrants do not suffer any mental or physical harm from the above students. Since it is a college that teaches social work, there are no forms of ragging in college. The rites of non-discrimination are practiced in the college on the basis of gender equality, socio-economic inequality. To date, no such complaint has been lodged with the committee. As the chairman of the committee, Dr. Arundhati Patil looks after the work.
- **B)** Internal Complaints Committee As per the bill passed in the Lok Sabha in 2013, a committee has been set up in the college for prevention of sexual harassment against women. Dr. Arundhati Patil works as a coordinator of the committee.
- C) Internal Quality Assurance Cell IQAC has been established in the college for quality enhancement. Efforts are made to enhance the quality of the college by exploring internal and external resources. As the coordinator of this committee, Prof. Dr. Rama Pandey oversees this work. In the academic year 2014-2015, the college was evaluated under NAAC. In order to enhance the internal quality of the college and the students, the committee held 06 meetings from time to time and carried out the instructions and facilities as demanded. Career Mentoring Camps, Competitive Examination Mentoring Camps and Mentoring Camps on Study Related Topics were organized for the students. On behalf of this committee, minorities, backward classes,

D) Social Justice and Empowerment Committee -



36) Co-curricular Activity:

Case Presentation: MSW students of first year were given topic for case presentation. Extension Activity: -

Seminar and Group Discussion: Student will take a selected topic for seminar and he / she has to present in the class room and group discussion will be organized once in a month for sharing of students, views, ideas and current social issues.

Collaboration and co ordinations:- College has collaborated with local organization and association for facilitating services to the community. Domestic, worker association, women, pensioners association, Andhashradha Nirmulan Samittee, Muslim Vikas Parishad, Labour Union at Sugar factory and Manavlok etc.

Community Services:- SHG formation, Association of farmers and youths, associations of domestic workers (Women), association and coordination with Hamal Mapadi organization, pensioner association etc.

Extra Curricular Activity:

With the aim of adding to the overall development of the students, classes are conducted on behalf of the college in relation to soft skills. After passing this objective students have to work in various government, semi-government offices, students are required to prepare resumes, administrative records, personal interview, how to apply etc. Guidance is given in context.
