### 1. Title of the Best Practice


"Thursday for Skill Development"

# 2. Objectives of the practice -

- To sensitize social work students for different social issues
- To realize them the dignity of work and commitment to integrated work culture.
- To provide learning opportunities to students for capacity building.

### 3. The Context-

Social Work is one of the most relevant and compatible disciplines to address complex issues and challenges in a comprehensive manner at societal level at large. Today the situation in society is getting more and more incorporeal due to socio economic and environmental degradation. The dynamics at village to global has been changing and become controversial raising the violation of human rights. In such situation intervention of professional social work is immensely required. However the capacity building for professional development of social work students is a great challenge and need to be tackled by adopting strategies to strengthen their skills, knowledge and attitude. The students enrolled to MSW course are from rigid cultural and rural background mostly. They lack communication skill, reading and writing proficiency, possess gender biased mind set, caste based conflicts and illogical attitude.



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#### 4. The Practice –

Special Thursday is a set of four activities which are planned distinctly for each Thursday in every month. It executed regularly throughout the year. Students and staff wear Khadi as a uniform and clean the surrounding together. Groups of students under the supervision of faculties contribute in cleaning. It helps to realize importance of team work and inculcate value dignity to work,

First Thursday - is planned for Skill Lab. Skill lab is a learning exercise for students. The laboratory method offers organized opportunities for trainees to develop skills which are required to resolve issues in various social settings. The skill laboratory also aims at enabling students to develop skills especially in the method of social work practice. The sessions are generally conducted by simulating situations so that the students can practice and develop necessary skills and attitude in a gender friendly environment.

Second Thursday - is planned for awareness Songs. Awareness songs are assumed as the starter to lead the programme with subject oriented massages. It also helps to create energetic just environment and feel people relaxed and switch their attention to the purpose of the programme. Thus awareness song is also a skill by which one can bring attention and participation of audience in a inclusive manner. Faculties and students perform group songs when they gathered at ' Kalyan Mandapam in Marathi as well as Hindi which are full of social oriented massages. It helps students to conduct meetings or programmes at community level in a democratic and friendly manner. 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Third Thursday – Every IIIrd Thirsday "Bhumika "a wall magazine is being displayed and presented by students. A group of students are assigned to prepare write up on specific mostly current social subjects. It helps student to improve communication skill, reading and writing skill as expected to the social work discipline. It notices the increased Stage courage and confidence, understanding of the specific subject.

Forth Thursday – It is an unique kind of best practice that focuses on Student led platform called "Parivartan College Katta "The idea is providing student an opportunity to build leadership qualities and managerial skills. Students constitute a committee from both the classes. They decide the plan and invite guests from various fields to the platform to share his/her work. Students interact with guests and build democratic partnership. It helps to acquire skills of holding and managing the programmers with coordination.

#### 5. Evidence of Success –

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"Special Thursday "is one of the best practices of our institution. These activities are regularly practiced in our institution. Shramadan, Khadi , Skill lab , Awareness songs and College Katta have definitely changed the perspectives of students. Student's particularly male students before admission to the MSW course possess a very conventional and gender biased mind set. They hesitate to clean primices with broom feeling disrespect to the simplicity and manual labor. We notice improved bonding among the students and skills like negotiation, identifying problems, planning and administration, evaluation at events in college and community level.

#### 4. The Practice


